#### 2. Ethical Breeding Practices

With over 50 years of breeding experience, we carefully select and match breeding parents to promote strong genetic diversity. Our poodle crossbreeds benefit from hybrid vigor, which significantly reduces the risk of inherited joint disorders compared to many purebred dogs.

# 3. Puppy Care and Development

We provide puppies with balanced nutrition, safe play environments, and appropriate early socialization. This foundation is essential in supporting healthy bone and joint development before they transition to their forever homes.

### 4. Understanding Genetic Limitations

Hip and elbow dysplasia are complex, polygenic conditions influenced by both genetics and environmental factors. Even with perfect parental health and regular veterinary checks, it is not possible to completely eliminate the risk of these conditions in offspring.

- A qualified veterinarian diagnoses the condition and it is confirmed by a second independent veterinary opinion

- The condition has not been caused or worsened by environmental factors such as injury, excessive exercise during growth, or poor nutrition
